NATIONAL CLIMATE GOVERNANCE SUMMIT 2023

Climate Governance Malaysia's inaugural National Climate Governance Summit in 2023 featured 105 speakers and 18 workshops over 3 days with substantial **online engagements** (via conference app), including:

- Event Engagement: Attendees created 21 meet-ups, shared 169 photos, posted 1712 community messages, posted 11 job postings, shared 172 articles.
- Event Agenda: Attendees had 7360 session views (including offline access), 1618 enrollments, 185 likes, 22 comments.
- Sponsor Highlights: 10 event sponsors received 807667 impressions.
- Event Networking: Attendees sent 2140 direct messages, scheduled 1 meeting, got 5872 profile views, did 436 contact exchanges.
